### ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister responsible for the Environment under section 28 of the Environmental Protection Agency Act, 1994 (Act 490) and on the advice of the Board these Regulations are made this 2626th day of April, 2002.

### L.I. 1652 amended

- **1.** The Environmental Assessment Regulations, 1999 (L.I 1652) referred to in the these Regulations as the "principal enactment", is amended
  - (a) by the substitution for regulation of the following

### "fees and charges for environmental permits and certificates

- 8(1) The fees and charges for permits specified in Schedules 2A and 2B to these Regulations shall be paid to the Agency in respect of the matters specified in relation to them in the Schedules.
- (2) The certificate fees specified in Schedule 2C to these Regulations shall be paid to the Agency in respect of the matters specified in relation to them"
- (b) by the insertion after regulation 8 of the following new regulation 8A as follows

### "Publication of notice of environmental permit"

8A The Agency shall publish in the Gazette and the mass media and in such form as the Agency shall determine notice of every environmental permit issued within 3 months of the date of issue of the permit.

### Insertion of Schedule 2A, 2B and 2C

**2.** The principal enactment is amended by the insertion after Schedule 2 of Schedules 2A, 2B and 2C as follows:
