L.I. 1357-Wildlife Conservation (Amendment) Regulations, 1988

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Provisional National Defence Council by section 11 of the Wild Animals Preservation Act 1961 (Act 43), this Regulation is made this 29th day of January, 1988.

- 1. The Wildlife Reserves (Amendment) Regulation, 1971 (L.I. 710) as amended by the Wildlife Reserves (Amendment) Regulations 1983 (L.I. 1284) are hereby further amended as follows:
